Junior and women championship in Bengaluru, India: The women's event seems to be quite successful in terms of participants (up to 25 players if Philippines is able to participate). Liubov Zhyltsova from Ukraine will be present to defend her title. There are fewer players in the juniors' event (14 participants at the moment). Marilyn Bland will be representing IBCA.

Panamerican in Salinas, Ecuador: No recent news about the number of participants. Piotr will be representing IBCA.

Olympiads in Serbia: the event will be held from 16 to 27 June, 2025 in Vrnacka Banja. .World Championship: The event will be held in Poland in the second half of September, 2025, together with the 1st Rapid IBCA World Championship. The IBCA Congress will take place during the Championship.
